The Proficiency Analytical Testing Board (PAT Board) oversees the governance, policies and processes, which are related to AIHA Proficiency Analytical Testing Programs, LLC (AIHA PAT Programs, LLC) and ensures the scientific integrity of the programs in accordance with documented duties & responsibilities (*AIHA PAT Board Duties and Responsibilities*). Board members are required to attend at least two meetings annually: once in conjunction with the AIHA's annual meeting (AIHce – May/June) and one in January or February. The AIHA PAT Programs, LLC will cover reasonable and customary travel expenses to each of these meetings that a participant's employer cannot or will not cover. See question nine, below, for specific commitment required.

To qualify to participate on the PAT Board, candidates should minimally meet the following requirements:

- The PAT Board candidate shall be a graduate of an accredited institution of higher education holding a bachelor's degree in industrial hygiene, chemistry, physics, engineering, biology or other scientific discipline.
- The PAT Board candidate has engaged a majority of his/her time in analytical laboratory activities (analysis or interpretation of data) for at least three years.

At any given time, the AIHA PAT Programs, LLC is looking for qualified individuals to represent the AIHA Proficiency Analytical Testing (PAT) Programs that we oversee. The PAT programs include Industrial Hygiene, Environmental Lead, Beryllium, Pharmaceuticals, Bulk Asbestos and Environmental Microbiology. As well, we welcome applications from laboratory data producers and/or laboratory data users and/or regulators of the laboratory industry. Representation for each program is generally broken out as follows:

- Up to eight (8) individuals will be elected/appointed to represent all aspects of the AIHA PAT Programs, LLC. and laboratory data producers and/or laboratory data users and/or regulators of the laboratory industry;
- Three (3) individuals will serve in officer positions (Chair, Vice Chair and Past Chair);

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In between meetings, members of the PAT Board are expected to participate in and contribute to ad hoc task forces appointed by the PAT Board or its chair, to electronically or otherwise vote on matters requiring PAT Board vote and to participate in conference calls as requested. PAT Board members also technically review PAT round data before it is released to participants.

In all, participation on the PAT Board carries with it a significant amount of responsibility and effort. In return for your efforts, you will have the opportunity to participate in an important process, contribute back to your profession, and to work with some outstanding industry leaders.

PAT Board participants are strongly encouraged to be members in good standing with the AIHA and the AIHA PAT Programs, LLC at the time of application and if elected, they should endeavor to remain members in good standing throughout their tenure on the Board.

This application will be shared with the PAT Board Nominating Committee and appropriate staff, only.
